

The Centre montérégien de réadaptation (CMR) is a public institution in the health and social service network offering services to persons with a physical disability.

MISSION

The mission of the CMR is to offer adaptation, rehabilitation and social integration services to persons who, because of their physical impairment require such services, as well as services of accompaniment and support for them and their families.

The CMR has a mandate to offer services to persons in the Montérégie who have a motor, hearing or language impairment.

A MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM LISTENS TO YOUR NEEDS

The CMR team is composed of some 600 employees who provide quality services to users and take care of managing the institution.

CMR CLINICAL APPROACH

The CMR team is guided by the conviction that a person with a physical impairment can, at his own

pace and according to his personal motivations, actualize his potential and assume social roles by reason of his age ad social identity.

Interventions designed to develop or recover autonomy

To enable the personalized development of rehabilitation interventions designed to develop or recover an autonomous lifestyle.

- Personal autonomy
- Daily living activities (nutrition, dressing, hygiene care)
- Moving around in the immediate environment
- Social and leisure autonomy
- Housekeeping activities
- Shopping
- Managing property
- Using public services
- Family relations
- Parental and conjugal relations
- Friendly relations
- Moving about in the community
- Leisure activities, games and sports
- School (daycare) and occupational autonomy
- Assistance required to support activities related to education or employment (doing homework, keeping an agenda, etc.)
- Participation in social activities in the daycare, school or occupational environment

Services focus on three goals

- The optimal development or recovery of the person's abilities
- Compensation of permanent disabilities
- Reducing situations of handicap

To actualize their interventions according to these guidelines, CMR professionals refer to conceptual models and therapeutic approaches: ecosystem approach and process of handicap production (PHP).

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

At the CMR, programs are designed according to the type of impairment (motor, hearing or language) and life cycle: youth (early childhood, school age and specialized schools), adults and seniors.

These are the programs offered to our clients:

- Program for Youth with a Motor Impairment
- Program for Adults with a Motor Impairment
- Traumatology Program
- Program for Youth with a Language Impairment
- Hearing Impairment Program
- Assistive Listening Devices Service
- Residential Resources Program
- Access to Technology and Communications Program
- Technical Aids Service
- Automobile Conduct and Adaptation of Vehicules

Services are provides by multidisciplinary team composed of physicians, health and social services professionals and specialized technicians.

SERVICE REQUESTS

The CMR is a specialized institution offering second-line services. A request for services can be made by a health professional or by the user. Referral mechanisms and forms required to submit a request for services to the programs offered at the CMR vary according to the three following types of service:

- Rehabilitation programs
- Technical Aids Service
- Other programs and services: Assistive Listening Devices Service and Residential Resources
